Each member's vote shall be recorded in the minutes on a roll call vote. Upon request, 13 14 any member's individual vote may be recorded in the minutes. No secret votes shall be used.<sup>3</sup> 15 CHAIRMAN'S PARTICIPATION 16 17 The person chairing a meeting may participate in discussion, make motions, and vote on all 18 issues as any other member without relinquishing the chair.<sup>4</sup> 19
