L is for Lila; that's my name!

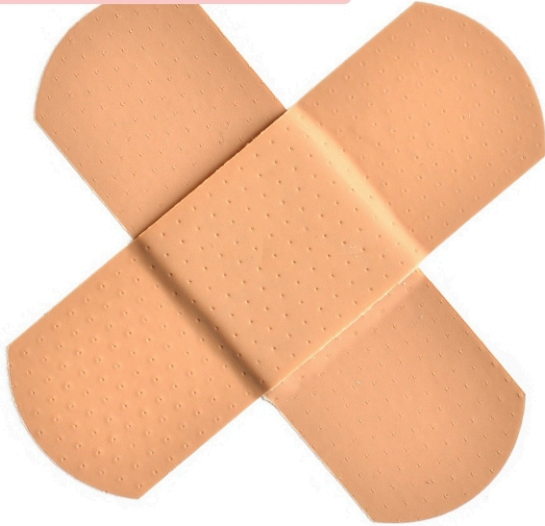


M is for mom; there are many on the farm.

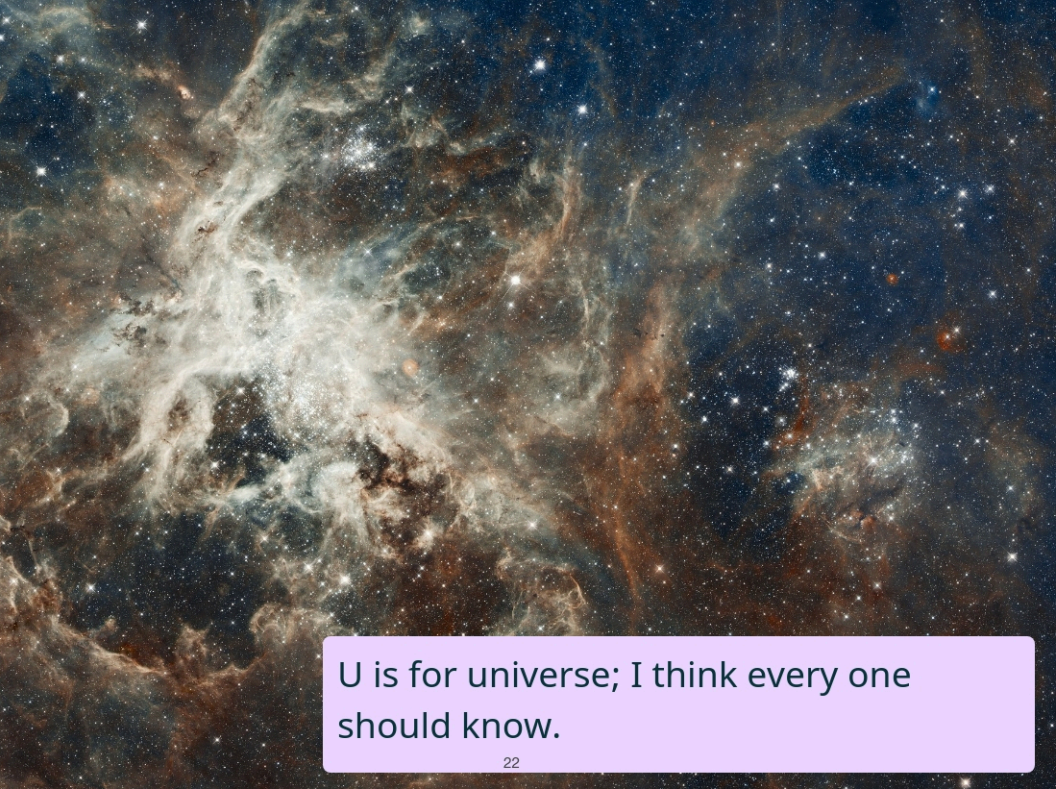
R is for rest; we rest on

T is for tools; you have to have them.







U is for universe; I think every one should know.
